## OFFICIAL VISIT FROM THE PRESIDENT OF CROATIA HER EXCELLENCY KOLINDA GRABAR-KITAROVIĆ, 19<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST, 2017



### **President's Report – September 2017**

The Society had the great honour of hosting the President of Croatia, Kolinda Grabar-Kitarović, and her delegation on Saturday the 19<sup>th</sup> of September. We had a great turnout, with well over 380 people attending the event. Goran Kačurov and our 'Kralj Tomislav' folklore ensemble put on an exceptional programme, and the President and her delegation were very impressed. Some members of the delegation stated that it was the best Croatian folklore performance that they had witnessed outside of Croatia. This is a great tribute to Goran Kačurov and all of the performers in 'Kralj Tomislav' – you did us proud and well done! You all put in a huge amount of effort and many practices over a short period of time, which made the final event even more remarkable.

President Kolinda Grabar-Kitarović also presented Goran Kačurov with a Croatian Presidential medal, which was in recognition for his services to Croatian culture. This was well deserved and a great honour – congratulations and well done Goran!

As well as the President's delegation and our Ambassador Dr Damir Kušen, we were also privileged to have a number of special guests attending. These included National Minister of Parliament Alfred Ngaro, Sir Peter Talley, Rose Ballinger (Delegat), Sir George Fistonich, and our Olympic champion, Mahe Drysdale. It was great to see some new faces at our Society and they all thoroughly enjoyed the evening with us.

I would like to personally thank everyone who worked so hard to make this event the success that it was. It was not easy and on behalf of all members, a big thank you for your selfless contributions, we appreciate you all! As at the 31st of July, the Society only had a mortgage of \$17,500 – which is likely to be completely paid off within the next 2 months. This is truly a great milestone in the Society's history, that we should all be proud of.
