ABOUT FACULTY OF CROATIAN STUDIES

Croatian Studies at the University of Zagreb was launched in 1992. The status of the faculty was reached on December 10, 2019, transforming into Faculty of Croatian Studies. Today, higher education in Faculty of Croatian Studies takes place in eight departments:

- Demography and the Croatian Diaspora
- Educational Sciences and Teacher Training
- Philosophy
- Communicology
- Croatology
- History
- Psychology
- Sociology

Research and teaching at Faculty of Croatian Studies focuses on traditional and contemporary cultural, identity, humanities and social issues related to the Republic of Croatia, Croatian people and migration, such as cultural, political intellectual history and reality; media public and personal communications; the activities of social groups; human experience and behavior; education and training; language development; open political, cultural, social and demographic issues of national, regional or European interest.

WHY STUDY AT FACULTY OF CROATIAN STUDIES

- The Agency for Science and Higher Education, in co-operation with foreign experts, declared in 2015 that Faculty of Croatian Studies was the best rated institution of higher education in the social and humanities fields.
- ➤ Teaching at Faculty of Croatian Studies takes place in smaller groups of students, which enables professors to clearly define the focus of their teaching, adapting to the interests and needs of the students while recognising their attitudes.

HOW TO ENROL IN YOUR DESIRED COURSE

Studies programs offered at Faculty of Croatian Studies (undergraduate level)

- Single major: Communicology, Croatology, History, Psychology, and Sociology
- Double major: Demography and the Croatian Diaspora, Philosophy and Culture, Communicology, Croatian, History, and Sociology

Submission of applications for enrollment in the first year of undergraduate study:

- The first deadline is **Sunday 5th July 2020** at 23.59 in accordance with Central European summer time
- ➤ The second deadline is **Sunday 13th September 2020 at 23.59** in accordance with Central European summer time.

Applications are submitted electronically on the Faculty of Croatian Studies website, where you can find the application, https://www.hrstud.unizg.hr/hrvati_izvan_rh Along with the application form, it is neccessary to attach scanned copies of the following documents: 1. domovnica or an extract from the Book of Croatian Nationals (if the applicant is a Croatian citizen) or a certificate / proof of foreign nationality (if the applicant is a foreign national), 2. statement of Croatian herritage, 3. motivation letter (in Croatian, English, Castilian/Spanish or German), 4. certificates for the last four grades of high school, 5. certificate of knowledge of the Croatian language at level B2, C1 or C2 (if available).	 Croatian herritage with residence outside Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Republic of Croatia; completed four-years of high school, this being, the four last years in at least twelve years of schooling; readiness to move to Zagreb and attend classes in Croatian For applicants who meet the above-mentioned enrollment requirements a meeting will be held primarily consisting of a discussion regarding their motivation to study and an evaluation of their knowledge of the Croatian language. The discussion will take place via a video call or in person at Croatian Studies, Borongajska cesta 83d, Zagreb, between the 7th and 9th July 2020 in the first intake period, or between the 15th and 17th September 2020 in the second intake period. Thus, the University opened spaces for the enrollment of 53 students, made available specifically for younger generation Croats living outside the Republic of Croatia, members of the Croatian minority and Croatian emigrants.
